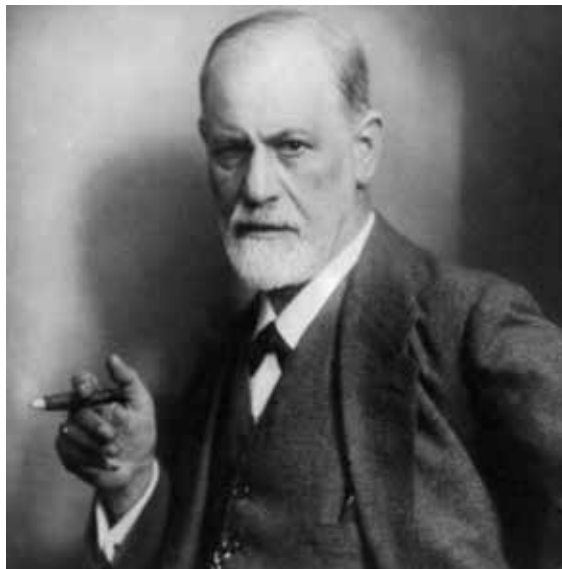

Freud's Cigar Box Goes on View at the Jewish Museum

As part of an exhibition of works from the Jewish Museum collection curated Barbara Bloom, called *As It Were...
