Opening: Dawn Kasper at David Lewis

For the Venice Biennale in 2017, Dawn Kasper set up a studio for six months and created music using a drum set, maracas, a keyboard, and other tools. “It’ll be kind of like, a little loose and fluid and drone-y and fun,” she told *ARTnews* at the time. Information about the contents of her latest exhibition, titled “Four Scores (Zero to Nothing),” is sparse: the gallery released a teaser image featuring a cloth floating down a river. But the show will include a series of four performances on Fridays during the show’s run, with Kasper in collaboration with painter James Krone; filmmaker, photographer, and performance artist Andrew Lampert; filmmaker Jeff Preiss; and composer, performer, and contemporary harpist Zeena Parkins.
